

**Meeting of the Waterbury Select Board
July 29, 2014
Main Street Fire Station**

Present: C. Nordle, Chair; C. Viens and J. Grenier (via phone), Select Board; and C. Lawrence, Town Clerk.

The meeting was called to order at 3:00pm.

No members of the public were present.

The Waterbury Animal Control Officer received a letter of complaint dated July 17th and delivered the letter to the Town Clerk on July 18th. The complainant and dog owner were notified of the hearing.

On July 25th, the dog owner requested a continuance until August 4th as she was unavailable on July 29th. The purpose of this meeting is to consider and act upon this request.

J. Grenier asked about the incident. On July 17th, a dog owned by Sandra D'Amico of Stuart Lane got loose and bit Robert Becker as he was at his mailbox. Mr. Becker required medical attention and filed a written complaint, initiation a vicious dog hearing. Historically, there have been issues with this dog. The dog was transported to Lamoille Kennels and remains there to date.

C. Viens made a motion to continue the hearing to August 4th at 6:00pm on the condition that the dog remains at Lamoille Kennels. The motion was seconded by J. Grenier and passed by those present.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:10pm.
