

What's Happening Behind the Fence?

Deconstruction:

We are nearing the completion of the material removals of the Deconstruction portion of the project with 16 buildings removed and just over 94% of the materials being reused or recycled and not simply placed in a landfill!

Sitework:

Our new underground utility work is underway with water, sanitary and storm drainage work being installed along the west side of the site.

Historic Core:

The selective demolition process is well underway on the interior of the Historic Core. Existing mechanical and electrical systems are being removed and structural framing improvements are underway as well.

New Office Building:

On the west side of the Historic Core the excavation and fills for the New Office Building foundation is also underway. Our new concrete footings and frost walls are being placed at this time. We even had help placing the first section from Governor Shumlin himself!

Central Plant:

The base slab at the wood chip fuel storage section of the new Central Plant has been placed and the walls will be formed in the coming weeks.

Safety:

It is a large site, so please be aware of changing conditions!
