- Caring for the Canopy Grant: The proposed use of the 5K awarded includes: *Focus will be addressing maintenance of recently planted trees* Pruning: Hold another pruning workshop with Caldwell Clark including Cemetery Commission will occur at the Winooski Street area of Hope Cemetery. Removal: as needed based on street inventory findings.

 Mulch: The grant can include purchase of mulch for key trees at Maple St. and Hope Cemetery, Pilgrim Park, and others if \$\$\$ allows.

 Inoculation of Ash Trees: 3 large Ash on South Main Street, 2 behind Prohibition Pig, 1 at Hope Cemetery (possible 2nd Inoculation). 2 at Hope Davey Park Cost versus benefit addressed, 1 tree on South Main should be removed. Bill W will investigate financial or town worker support.

 Purchase pruning tools and an iPad to facilitate Street Tree Inventory
- <u>Mowing behind library:</u> Bill to request mowing around fruit trees planted last year. There will be a new Children's Garden within the Community Garden area as described by Rec. Director, Katarina Lisaius.
- <u>Mulching and restoration of surrounding grass invasion:</u> Mike L will coordinate with local companies and town public works. WTB will also participate.
- Coordinate with afterschool Rec Program if any students from last year would be around to be included with care if fruit trees planted Spring 2023.
- Next meeting: April 12, 2024. Steele Room, 1230. Agenda items brought forth. Joanne Garton will be invited to launch Fruit Tree Inventory.
