

## Waterbury Cemetery Commission

May 5, 2015 Meeting

Meeting began at 4PM

Hope Cemetery. John reported that the warned meeting to discuss disbanding Waterbury Cemetery Association (Hope Cemetery) was held on April 30, 2015 with Bill Morse and John in attendance. Since there were no other members present it was decided to disband the Association. Bill Morse will meet with Bill Shepeluk to discuss distribution of assets and liabilities to the Town.

John has spoken with Matt F. about continuing cleaning of stones in Section B. There are 296 stones in this section and Matt would like to charge \$12.50/per stone. This is more that he charged for Section A. John will get a quote from Walbridge to compare. The Water Department will take out old fence at the Main Street entrance and add boulders. New trees have been marked for placement and it is hoped they will be planted this month.

Maple Street Cemetery. Chad reported that a contract has been signed to purchase a new 36" mower for Maple Street and Old Center Cemeteries. It is a walk behind mower and price is \$3,400. Chad has been using his own back pack leaf blower. Flag pole needs fixing and old cedars need trimming around bulletin board. It was mentioned that

perhaps the American Legion would provide a new pole. David Dow should be contacted to see if that is possible.

John, Jack and Jane Brown staked out placement for the 10 maple trees and 2 oak trees. Planting will be done this month.

The draft of Cemetery Rules and Regulations were reviewed and discussed at length. Corrections were given to Chad for revision and presentation at the June meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 5:40pm. Next meeting June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4:00pm, second floor conference room of the Steele Block.
