Minutes of May 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting approved.

**Hope Cemetery:** John has contacted and will meet with Scott from Heritage Restoration of Newport to talk about repair and foundation work of stones. Jack and Barbara would also like to meet at that time.

Transfer of funds from the Association is still pending. Hold up seems to be the select board is hesitant to sign MOU until all records have been transferred including total amount of money. Bill Morse has not turned over the records.

Karen Holway has request to sell two of her lots in Section G. There are a total of eight lots. It was agreed to do so by paying her \$600 and issue a new deed and transfer the old deed to the Town.

**Maple Street Cemetery:** Town is doing a good job in mowing and maintaining the cemetery. The Historical Society held its annual Memorial Day “Ghost Walk” in May there.

**Other Business:** There have been 17 burials so far this year. Three lots have been sold.

Mark Backus has been in contact with John about stone replacement of his ancestor Zachariah Basset in Johnson Cemetery. Basset was a Revolutionary War soldier whose stone has been missing, presumed stolen, for a few years. The Sons of the American Revolution has applied for a grant to replace the marker.
