- We welcomed newly elected commissioner Jan
- Minutes of February 6<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved
- Bill handed out financial statements and we reviewed them. The market has been very volatile this year and our investments have dropped \$10,000 since January. However, in 2017 we had a gain of \$23,000.
- We went through our “to-do list” for 2018, John will speak with Public Works Director to make sure our needs are put on the list of things to do this year:
  - 1.) Resurface roads in Maple Street Cemetery
  - 2.) Brush clearing of the entire perimeter of Hope Cemetery
  - 3.) Restoration of gravestones (ongoing)
  - 4.) Once a year maintenance of Demeritt, Johnson, Loomis Hill
  - 5.) Sign at Old Center Cemetery and perhaps Maple Street
  - 6.) Install a natural barrier at the lower edge of Hope between community gardens and cemetery lots.
  - 7.) Upper fountain rehabilitation in Hope with plantings
  - 8.) Remove cedar trees and bulletin board in Maple Street and replace with sign and other vegetation.
- We set rates for 2018: grave opening - \$900., Cremains - \$300., Vault - \$300., single lot - \$600., full lot - \$1,200.
- Meeting adjourned at 5:30.
