Tom also informed the committee that he interviewed someone for the animal control officer and felt John might interview her for a part-time cemetery worker.

John's Report

John mentioned that we might consider approaching the selectboard at the end of the year increasing town's support of the cemetery budget. John will check to see if the Town's Transportation Department could cut down a tree at the Route 100 cemetery and repair the link gate fence.

Miscellaneous

Jan mentioned the need for training some staff how to prune and wondered if Maddie could do the training. John look will investigate this.

Committee hopes to visit some of the cemeteries in June and looked at June 14 and 28.
