**Flooding Updates and unmet/emerging needs:** Vactor Trucks hugely useful. S. Burlington truck possibly available. The Wastewater Treatment Plant is gaining now. No assessment on the Pump Station as of this afternoon. Most homes are not past Stage 3 so the call for cleaning supplies has not come but it is anticipated soon. There are six dumpsters that have been placed in the flooded areas for homes to use. There will be an all-metal recycling dumpster at Stanley Hall. Meals are being prepared and delivered to staff and volunteers – BIG THANK YOU'S!

**Volunteer Planning and Efforts / Public:** Volunteers are on the ground today and working to assist homeowners. There are 580 responses on the resource spreadsheet for help and volunteers. Volunteer Organizers are working to sift through the responses and identify needs. Folks are already moving appliances to Stanley Hall.
