Ms. Fillmore was recommended by Jeanne Kirby of Revitalizing Waterbury and has done work for them. The Village president had sent back ground material of earlier documents to Ms. Fillmore for review in preparation for the meeting.

Invited to attend the meeting were Police Chief Joby Feccia, Officer Tim Burrows, Manager William Shepeluk, Mary Fillmore, and the three Trustees. Everett Coffey attended the meeting as a member of the public.

During the discussion people shared their concerns about past communications and provided goals for going forward. Ms. Fillmore asked questions of the members who responded. Ms. Fillmore will submit a proposal to the Trustees for review.



The meeting was adjourned at 2:00p.m.




