

**WATERBURY VILLAGE TRUSTEES**

Municipal Office

August 24, 2011

Present: P. Howard Flanders, Village President; L. Sayah and N. Howell-Sherman, Trustees; J. Feccia, Police Chief; and C. Lawrence, Village Clerk.

The meeting was called to order at 8:35a.m.

The Trustees reviewed a request for parking at One Stowe Street from Danielle Nichols/Madcam Real Estate for a wine bar/retail shop. A discussion ensued about the limited parking in the Village, and that parking is on a first come-first served basis. N. Howell Sherman made a motion to approve 6 on-street parking spaces for permit application #20-11V at One Stowe Street. The motion was seconded by L. Sayah and passed unanimously.

James King on Union Street has complained about speeding and a commercial truck using the street on a routine basis. J. Feccia spoke with Mr. King about his concerns. J. Feccia determined that the truck is leased by Ryder and is still researching who is driving the truck, and he will contact GMCR management about the posted roads. Speeding on Union Street seems to occur early on weekend mornings and during the late afternoon. J. Feccia will schedule more police presence on the street. A discussion followed about the use of speed bumps on certain streets in the Village. J. Feccia will get information from 'All Traffic Solutions'; a company that sells speed machines that go on posts to record traffic/speed patterns. He will report back at the September 14<sup>th</sup> meeting about the machines and patrol of certain Village streets.

N. Howell-Sherman made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 8<sup>th</sup>, July 20<sup>th</sup>, July 20<sup>th</sup> Joint Meeting, August 4<sup>th</sup> and August 15<sup>th</sup> meetings. The motion was seconded by L. Sayah and passed unanimously.

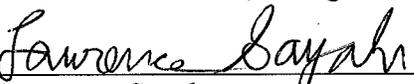
There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:20a.m.
