The Planning Commission is still working on Phase I of the Zoning Bylaws Rewrite. They have started to work with the consultants to get assistance on the rewrite within the Downtown. The governor is going back to reconsider the continued funding of the motel housing program.

# Review of data and drafting and next steps for Housing Needs Assessment

Joe C. took a look at the Housing Needs Assessment and reviewed it to measure what data is still applicable since the COVID-19 Pandemic. Joe also summarized the document to the task force and went through what a possible action plan could be. A lot of the data that is referenced in the document can be found on <u>HousingData.org</u>. The task force went through important data from HousingData.org. We discussed possible next steps based on the presentation. We also brainstormed questions for the community survey.
