**Procurement & Installation
Black Colonial Aluminum Fencing**

May 16, 2016

Introduction:

The Town of Waterbury is seeking proposals for the procurement and installation of 182' of Colonial Aluminum black ornamental fencing along the interstate access road leading into the new Waterbury Round-a-bout.

As part of the Waterbury Round-a-bout project, chain link fence was installed along the road and community consensus is the fence is inconsistent with the visual aesthetic of the new round-a-bout. Our goal is to install a fence that creates a less institutional look and feel and is more consistent with the new period lighting and beautiful landscaping throughout the Round-a-bout.

Project Description:

Project includes procurement and installation of 182' of Colonial Aluminum black ornamental fencing along the interstate access road leading into the Round-a-bout (fencing on the right side of the photo below).



We are considering both a 5' and 6' fence. The fence needs to be tall enough to camouflage the lower 4' fence on the left side of the photo above. At this time, we are not intending to replace the lower fence unless the outer fence does not adequately camouflage the lower fence. As such, we would like pricing for both 5' and 6' fencing and options for Universal Plus and Standard Colonial Aluminum fencing for the outer (road side fence):

Proposal Requirements:

Outer (roadside fence)

Option 1: Colonial Universal Plus – 182 feet

Specification - 1 1/2" x 1 1/4" Rails & 3/4" Pickets

- 1a. Fencing - 5' high x 8' wide
- 1b. 6' high x 8' wide

Option 2: Colonial Universal (standard) – 182 feet

Specification - 1" x 5/8" Pickets

- 2a. 5' high x 8' wide
- 2b. 6' high x 8' wide



All quotes should include pricing broken down as follows:

- Cost of fencing materials
- Removal of existing chain link fence and posts (removed materials to be saved for the Town of Waterbury)
- Installation of new posts - dig new holes and plant posts, install fence

- Ensure that existing stay matte (where existing posts are installed) is restored to current condition.
- Ensure nearby trees are not disturbed.

Project Schedule:

The project will take place during the Summer of 2016, after adequate funds have been raised.

Payment Provisions:

Payment will be made on a monthly basis upon receipt of an itemized invoice of work completed to date. The final payment will be made once the installation of the fence is completed satisfactorily.

The Town and Village reserve the right to reject any or all proposals. Interested firms or individuals should submit two copies of a written proposal, including one copy of work-product examples, as well as an electronic version of the proposal (PDF or Word/Office document), by 12:00 p.m. on May 30th, to:
