  - e. What special resources can be brought in to assist and what specialty companies should be identified. Does Waterbury have contracts with any of these companies/resources?
  - f. All these items need to be inventoried and maintained with review on a regularly scheduled basis.
  - g. Team Rubicon for training and other support.

This list is a starting point that identifies a lot of the items to address but certainly needs everyone's input and thoughts and the best means for accomplishing them.
