Project History


- Bridge constructed in 1928 the existing structure is 42' long and 27' wide
- Current bridge deck rating of 5 (fair), superstructure rating of 5 (fair) and substructure rating of 5 (fair)
- 2021 engineering study conducted to evaluate alternatives and determined a full bridge replacement was best





Project Overview – New Bridge

- Single span rigid concrete frame structure, buried structure
- Roadway specifications
 - -32-foot roadway, 4-foot shoulders and 5-foot sidewalks






Project Overview

- Full replacement of bridge #36, buried structures and sewer relocation on Stowe Street over Thatcher Brook
- Contractor is J Hutchins Inc.
- Estimated overall Construction cost is \$3.4 million, estimated overall Project cost is around \$4.3 million





Construction Schedule






Traffic Detours

- Two detours will be utilized during construction
 - -60-day bridge closure, with signed detour route along
 Waterbury-Stowe Rd (VT 100),
 US 2 and Stowe St
 - –Up to a 21-day closure at Lincoln Street with a signed detour along Perry Hill Rd, Kneeland Flats Rd, Guptil Rd, and Waterbury-Stowe Rd (VT 100)






Stowe Street Detour




Lincoln Street Detour



Transportation Changes During Construction


- Temporary Park & Ride relocation to Stanley/Wasson Lot in the State Office Complex accessibly from Park Row
- Waterbury Park & Ride to close early June
- Temporary Park & Ride will be open beginning in early June





Transportation Changes During Construction

- Rural Community Transit and Green Mountain Transit will have a temporary bus stop at the relocated Park & Ride in the Stanley/Wasson Lot. This will begin in mid-June
