

- DOWNTOWN WATERBURY PARKING - A PRIMER & REMINDER

The Village of Waterbury has recently updated parking ordinance regulations reflecting an acknowledgement and commitment to work toward encouraging turnover of premium restricted 2-hour parking within the downtown village.

Who uses parking spaces in downtown Waterbury?

Residents, customers, clients, employers, employees, locals, visitors, and persons with disabilities park in downtown Waterbury.

Does it make a difference where I park?

Yes, where you park can make a big difference. A simple way to support local businesses is to be thoughtful when choosing your parking space. Remember customers and clients are looking for parking as close to their destination as possible. If you live or work in downtown your car may be parked for several hours at a time. You're being a good neighbor when you park a short distance away from your home, office or business in an unrestricted parking spot.

Where are the 24-hour municipal parking areas downtown?

The color-coded map below shows where municipal parking lots are in downtown. Recently several new signs were installed by the Town of Waterbury that clearly show where to turn and park. The signs look like this:



Where is there restricted on-street parking?

The map also shows where there are 2-hour and 15-minute restricted parking spaces. There is signage that conveys the time limit and which spaces it applies to. Remember to pay attention to signs during the winter when seasonal parking restrictions go into effect.
