Ned Houston from Waterbury Center, (a resident since 1988 and an original member of the bike path group that started in the 80s/90s called Green Paths of Waterbury). Ned is proposing an upgrade to the community path that leads from the end of Lincoln Street to Guptil Road. The 2 steep grades on the path could be reworked with switchbacks to help with better access. He met with 2 contractors and got a price. Each portion would be 10 to 15K. Path in general could use some sprucing up, a picnic table, widening of the path, fixing over grown vegetation etc. It is under utilized piece of town property. This is town asset that we should make more usable. The old group has \$2500 left in the bank that could be used as a down payment to the start of the maintenance. WATA may be able to contribute to the path. Needs maintenance - redesign, a general upgrade. Rec committee will help guide the approach to funding and regular maintenance. This has the full support of the rec committee.

Jane Brown is stepping down as a recreation committee member.
